

PROPER CLASS BEHAVIOR

In order for an atmosphere of learning to exist in the classroom, it is necessary that students be aware of and adhere to certain guidelines for behavior. The following guidelines for behavior will be observed in this classroom:

- 1.) When the instructor is talking, no one else is talking.
- 2.) If, to ask a question or to comment on the current classroom discussion, students wish to speak out, they will raise their hand and be called on **BEFORE** speaking. (Exceptions will be certain group discussion/response situations.)
- 3.) There will be no action by any student in the classroom that will distract (**or be perceived by the instructor to distract**) or disrupt the other students in the class or the instructor. Examples will include rudeness, making of noises, throwing something, or writing letters/homework during class.
- 4.) Talking back to the instructor in a rude or unnecessarily argumentative fashion will not be tolerated.
