

## **SEQA Review**

The New York State Education Department's Office of Vocational and Educational Services for Individuals with Disabilities has initiated a Special Education Quality Assurance (SEQA) Programs and Services Focused Review in Wayland-Cohocton School District during the 2009-2010 school year. The purpose of this review is to assess the district's compliance with selected federal and State laws and regulations governing the education of students with disabilities.

The review will be conducted by the SEQA Western New York Regional Office and will include representatives from the school district. The review process will involve a review of school records of selected students with disabilities, classroom visitations and interviews. In addition, meetings of the Committee on Special Education will be observed.
