During the summer, you can help your third grader get ready for his/her daily classes by purchasing the following items. Please purchase the items listed und All Third Graders and all of the items listed under your child's teacher's name.

### **ALL THIRD GRADERS**

- Pencils-2 packages of 10 or more (American made work best)
- Cap Erasers – 1 package
- Lined loose-leaf paper, wide ruled- 1 package
- Crayons, box of 24-big boxes not necessary, no room to store them!
- 6 plain pocket folders-blue, red, green, yellow, purple, orange (not Mrs. Kemp's class)
- Box of colored pencils-box of 8 or 12 is fine.
- Art shirt
- 2 boxes of tissues

# FIRST GRADE SUPPLY LIST

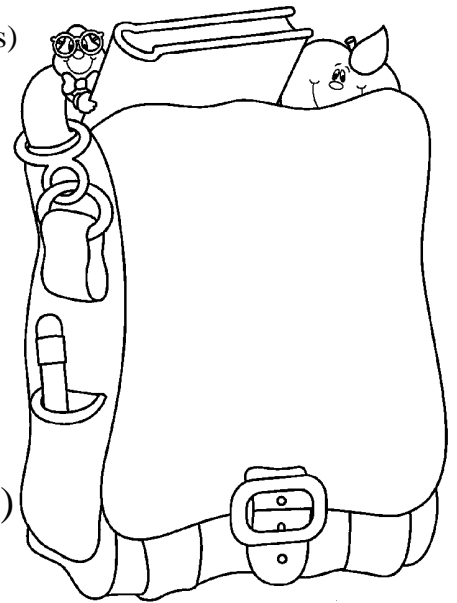

Welcome to first grade!! We know next year will be an exciting year for your child. Below is a list of supplies that your first grader will be needing in September.

- 2 packages of yellow #2 pencils (to be shared with the class)
- 1 pack of regular Crayola crayons – 24 count
- 2 white glue sticks
- 1- 4 oz. white Elmer's glue
- 1 large pink eraser
- Pencil box
- Large box of tissues (to be shared with the class)
- Large box of tissues (to be shared with the class)
- 1 box of baggies ( girls – gallon, boys – quart)
- 1 bottle of (hand sanitizer – girls, liquid soap – boys)
- Sneakers for gym
- An art shirt – any old shirt will do
- Backpack

## KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST 2010-2011

**Large** Backpack with 2 straps (Big enough to hold large books, folders, lunch pail, etc.). No wheels please. They are hard to get on the bus and too dangerous.

Art Shirt (an old adult T-shirt works best so the children can pull them on by themselves)

Sneakers (Daily for Physical Education and Playground)

12 Elmers Glue Sticks (Kindergarten students go through them **very** quickly!)

2 Boxes of 24 count Crayola Crayons (1 to be used first semester and 1 to be used second semester)  
**(Please do not buy jumbo, fluorescent, scented or glitter)**

1 Large pink erasers (Please no decorative shapes, colors, etc.)

2 Heavy duty bottom pocket folders (to take papers home in)

1 Bottle of hand sanitizer

1 hard plastic hinged crayon box - approximately 6" x 9" to hold crayons, pencils, scissors, etc.  
Please make sure your child can open and close it independently.

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS SHOULD BE PURCHASED TO SHARE WITH THE CLASS

1 box of tissues

1 box of Ziploc freezer bags - girls should bring quart size and boys should bring  
gallon size

1 bottle of hand sanitizer

1 bottle of antibacterial pump hand soap

**PLEASE BE SURE TO LABEL ALL ITEMS! PLEASE DO NOT send scissors, pencils, rulers, paper, markers or colored pencils. These items will be provided by the classroom.**
