Advanced Coursework

WCCS offers AP Music Theory, AP Calculus, AP English, AP Government and Politics, AP World History, AP Biology, and AP United States History. In addition, we have offered the following college level courses on the WCCS campus through Genesee Community College, Alfred State College, and beginning in the 2011-12 school year Corning Community College: French IV and V Spanish IV and V, Accounting, English Composition, Writing, Statistics, General Psychology, Cell Biology, Environmental Chemistry, and Life Transitions. Students who attend the Health Careers Academy may earn 15 additional college credits. These AP and college level courses are taught at WCCS by our teaching staff when the master schedule, student requests, and teaching certification permit. We also offer a program of acceleration whereby some students may take and earn high school credit for or Algebra, Earth Science, US History and foreign language during eighth grade.
