

# Test Corrections

If you wish you may do test corrections to earn more credit on a test. You do not have to do the corrections they are voluntary and the credit acts like extra credit. If you do choose to do corrections you must attempt to do corrections for all answers that you did not get full credit for. I will give you  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the credit you lost on the question if you get the answer right. If you scored a 60 on a test and do the corrections then you could get as high as an 80 after corrections. Remember I am here 13<sup>th</sup> (unless there is a meeting) to help you.

## Rules for doing test corrections

1. When I correct the test I give you the answers to the multiple choice questions. So ALL MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS MUST GIVE THE REASON FOR THE CORRECT ANSWER. That is you must reference where the material was covered whether it is in your book, notes or vocabulary. A reference includes where the information was found with page number or title of notes sheet with the number of the note on the sheet.
2. For part II questions if it was fill in the blank just simply give me the correct answer. If it was a choice to be made then you need to tell me the right choice and why as you did above for multiple choice questions,
3. For graph questions you can redraw the graph and show your work.
4. For math problems you can show work.
5. You have 1 week from the time you get the test back.
